


Schloss Johannisberg awarded as one of "The World's Most Admired Wine Brands" by Drinks International

Once again, Schloss Johannisberg is the only German winery to be included in the prestigious list of "The World's Most Admired Wine Brands 2024" published by the international trade publication "Drinks International". Schloss Johannisberg is listed in 44th place in the current edition and is thus once again part of the exclusive group of the 50 most admired wineries in the world. A total of 34 European brands and 16 representatives from outside Europe were honored with a ranking this year.

"Our entire team is once again honoured to receive this award", says Stefan Doktor, Estate Manager. "It proofs that our efforts to produce wines at highest level are successful. This motivates us to consistently continue our high-quality approach."

For the past 14 years Drinks International has built up a comprehensive voting academy. According to editor Shay Waterworth, the criteria of wine quality, value for money and strength of brand & marketing were decisive for the vote.
